

GUIDELINES FOR ANESTHESIA TECHNICIAN LICENSURE WITHIN DHCC

An applicant for licensure to practice as an anesthesia technician in the DHCC must meet the following requirements in order to qualify for licensure:

Anesthesia Technician:

- Graduated from an anesthetic technology course from an accredited educational institution, college or university.

Or

- Is a registered nurse graduated from an anesthesia nurse program from an accredited educational institution, college or university.

Or

- Is a respiratory therapist having graduated from an anesthesia assistant program from an accredited educational institution, college or university:
 - Current and valid Basic Life Support (BLS) certificate
 - 2 years experience in designated field
 - English proficiency programs, if the language of instruction of the anesthesia technology program is not in English
 - Favorable references
