

GUIDELINES FOR DENTAL HYGIENIST LICENSURE WITHIN DHCC

An applicant for licensure to practice dental hygiene in the DHCC must meet the following requirements in order to qualify for licensure:

Dental Hygienist:

- Graduate of an accredited high school or hold a certificate of high school equivalency
- Graduate of a recognized school of dentistry or dental hygiene
- Must include 2 full years of academic instruction or its equivalent at the postsecondary level
- A current license, registration, or certificate to practice
- Demonstrated proof of a license from the applicant's country of education
- A certificate of good standing from each country where the applicant has held or currently holds a license to practice
- 1 yr experience in designated field
- English proficiency programs, if the language of instruction of the program is not in English
- Favorable references
