

GUIDELINES FOR OPTOMETRY LICENSURE WITHIN DHCC

An applicant for licensure to practice optometry in the DHCC must meet the following requirements in order to qualify for licensure:

Optometry:

- Minimum of a 4 year Bachelors degree in optometry from a recognized educational institution, college or university
 - Syllabus pattern and competency attainment recommended by the World Council of Optometry
- A current license, registration or certificate to practice
- Demonstrated proof of a license from the applicant's country of education
- A certificate of good standing from each country where the applicant has held or currently holds a license to practice
- 1 yr experience in designated field
- English proficiency programs, if the language of instruction of the optometry program is not in English
- Favorable references
