

GUIDELINES FOR PODIATRY LICENSURE WITHIN DHCC

An applicant for licensure to practice podiatry in the DHCC must meet the following requirements in order to qualify for licensure:

Podiatrist:

- Minimum 4 year degree in a podiatry program from an accredited educational institution, college or university.
- Completion of 1 year post graduate residency program or demonstrates to the Licensing Board's satisfaction, experience in the practice of podiatry that meets or exceeds the minimum residency requirements
- A current license, registration, or certificate to practice
- Demonstrated proof of a license from the applicant's country of education
- Successful completion of the national board exams in country of training
- A certificate of good standing from each country where the applicant has held or currently holds a license to practice
- 2 years experience in designated field
- English proficiency programs, if the language of instruction of the podiatry program is not in English
- Favorable references
