

GUIDELINES FOR PROSTHETIST LICENSURE APPLICATION

An applicant for licensure as a prosthetist or related field in the DHCC must meet the following requirements in order to qualify for licensure:

Prosthetist:

- Having graduated from a Bachelor of Science in Orthotics and Prosthetics **or** a Bachelor's degree in Prosthetics program from an accredited educational institution, college or university
- A current license, registration or certificate to practice
- A certificate of good standing from each country where the applicant has held or currently holds a license to practice
- 2 years experience in designated field
- English proficiency programs, if the language of instruction of the prosthetic program is not in English
- Favorable references

Prosthetist Technician

- High school graduate (accredited) or equivalency of a high school certificate
- Minimum two (2) year diploma in Orthotics and Prosthetics **or** a Prosthetics program from an accredited institution, college or university
- 2 years experience in designated field
- English proficiency programs, if the language of instruction of the prosthetist Program is not in English
- Favorable references
