

GUIDELINES FOR PSYCHOLOGY LICENSURE WITHIN DHCC

An applicant for licensure to practice psychology in the DHCC must meet the following requirements in order to qualify for licensure:

Psychologist:

- Doctoral degree (P h.D, Psy.D) from a recognized institution. Program includes both a practical and internship.
 - o Minimum of 3 years of graduate study (in the curriculum) including training in:
 - Research design and methodology
 - Statistics and psychometrics
 - o Core program requires competency to be demonstrated in
 - Biological bases of behavior
 - Cognitive bases of behavior
 - Social bases for behavior
 - Individual differences
 - Scientific and professional ethics and standards
- Completion of 2 years supervised professional experience of which :
 - o 1 year shall be an internship program and 1 year which may be a postdoctoral
- A current license, registration, or certificate to practice
- Demonstrated proof of a license from the applicant's country of education
- A certificate of good standing from each country where the applicant has held or currently holds a license to practice
- 1 yr experience in designated field
- English proficiency programs, if the language of instruction of the psychology program is not in English
- Favorable references
