

GUIDELINES FOR Guided Imagery LICENSURE WITHIN DHCC

Licensure:

In addition to licensure requirements as per the “Application for Guided Imagery License”, each licensure applicant must meet all of the following education and training per category:

For Guided Imagery Instructor Licensure

- a) A License by the Licensing Board to Healthcare Professionals to serve as Licensed Healthcare professional in the DHCC as a Conventional or CAM Professional; **AND**
- b) The institution that offers the Guided Imagery education program shall be accredited as an institution of higher education by the country or state in which it is based; **AND**
- c) The Guided Imagery training program shall include training in anatomy and physiology; **AND**
- d) The Guided Imagery training program shall be at least 150 hours and include at least 50 hours of classes with small group supervision; **AND**
- e) Full-time Guided Imagery practice/teaching experience of at least 3 years; **AND**
- f) All Applicants must have a personal interview.

Recognized Training Programs and Associations

- a) Academy for Guided Imagery- California

Re- License

- a) Continuous Education requirement of fifteen (15) accredited hours within the last two (2) years. Of these 15 hours, 10 hours shall be in the area of their Guided Imagery specialty and 5 hours shall be in the area of general medicine.

Please note: Evidence of malpractice insurance is required before a license can be issued, make sure to provide the licensing department with a copy of your insurance policy whenever applicable.
