**TO: ALL CONSULTANTS, CONTRACTORS AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT**

**SUBJECT: WARNING LIGHTS ON HIGH RISE BUILDINGS AND CRANES**

With reference to the above subject and further to requirements of **Zoning Authority Health, Safety and Environment Regulation 6(P) (5) (v)** (Any tower crane selected for use on the construction site shall be positioned with adequate precautions against aerial obstruction for low flying aircraft/helicopters be provided with warning lights) **and Dubai Municipality Circular No. 149 Ref: 812/02/02/3/7183 dated: 04/04/2007**, it is reminded to comply with the following:

- 1) All tower cranes above 30 meters height must be fitted with flashing lights.
- 2) All mobile cranes with boom length of 30 meters or more must be fitted with warning lights and must be ON while the crane is working.
- 3) All building structures completed or under construction or on-hold/suspended with a height of 60 meters or above must be fitted with flashing lights. .
- 4) Construction sites shall be provided with suitable and sufficient lighting during night time.
- 5) All the stationery warning/flashing lights must be ON 24 Hours even on holidays.

Please note that complying with the above requirements is mandatory to prevent accidents.
